Yuva Eco Holiday Centre in southwest Anatolia is a drawing and painting paradise. We will be working outside in Yuva's glorious surroundings of ancient terraces, forest and mountains, right by the sea.

Beginners and more advanced students are very welcome to join this week. We will be using watercolour to explore the flowers and landscape of this most beautiful part of the Turkish Coast. Guests may decide what they want to do when they arrive at Yuva. Some may wish to concentrate on the plant life, which is a wonderful way to get to know the place, others on landscape.

The aim of the course is to encourage confidence in developing your own drawing and painting. There will be advice on drawing, colour mixing, observation and a practical approach to methods and materials. It is a wonderful opportunity to work in a different light and with such brilliant colours.

There will be classes on 5 days from 10am -1pm. The afternoons will be free but for those who wish to continue with their work Gabriel will be around to give help where needed. In the evening before supper we will meet to discuss work that has been done. There will be a free day when you can go on an excursion, continue your drawing/painting or just relax. If you are a beginner, you will find lots of encouragement and basic guidance to get you started. Intermediate levels will learn and share new skills. If you are a skilled artist, you may simply wish to create more opportunities to paint and draw. After dinner we relax and chat or create our own entertainment. There will also be local guided walks on 3 afternoons.

Gabriel Sempill studied at the Royal College of Art and is an illustrator, potter and painter, working for the British Museum and the Natural History Museum. Since the 1980s Gabriel has concentrated on drawing and printmaking with a number of solo exhibitions around London, as well as taking part in mixed exhibitions at the Mall Galleries and the Royal Academy. Currently she works in London and Scotland and teaches in both.
